We are a no-nut school. There are children in school with a very serious nut allergy so please avoid sending any food containing nuts (including Nutella). Thank you.

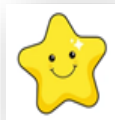

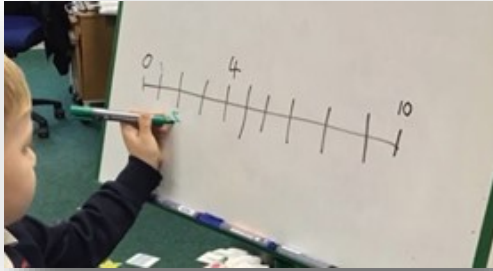

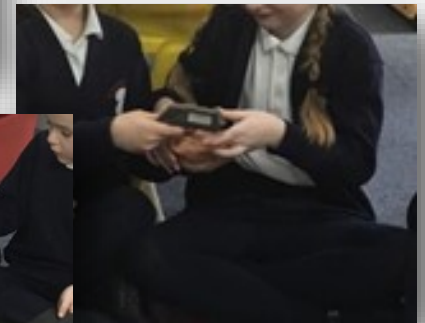

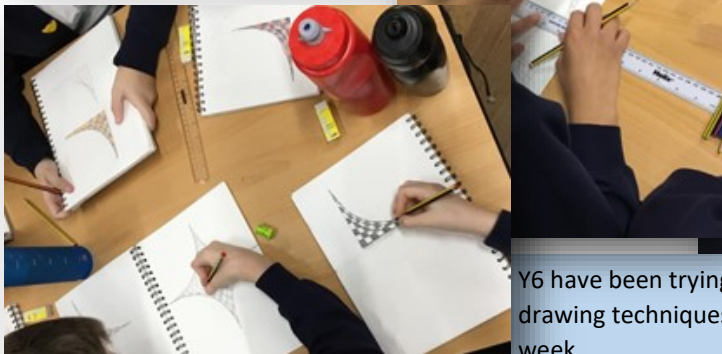
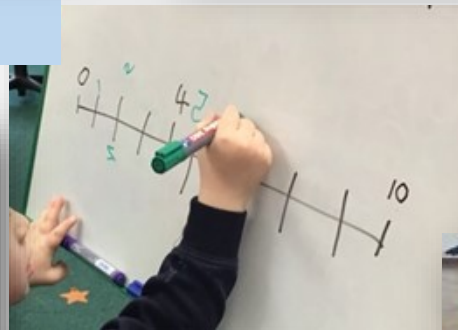
Snapshot of the week:

Sports News:

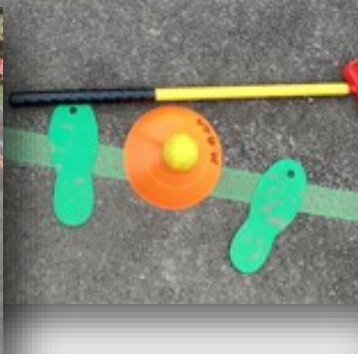
