The school gates (and classroom doors) close at 8:45am to ensure all children are registered 'present'. Too many 'late' marks will affect your child's attendance.

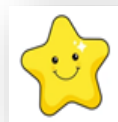

**Archie E 4RD** chosen by a random generator: —she gets to choose a book from Miss Bowers' selection of prize books.

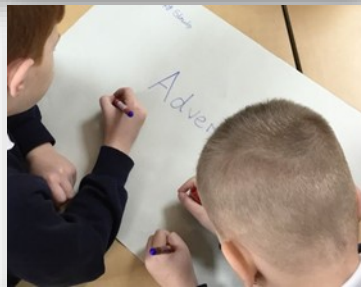
Snapshot of the week:



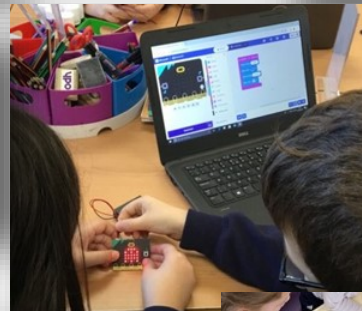
The children in year 4 were working on partner balances. Moving on from using mats to using benches and table tops.

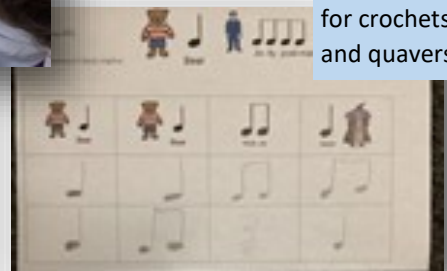
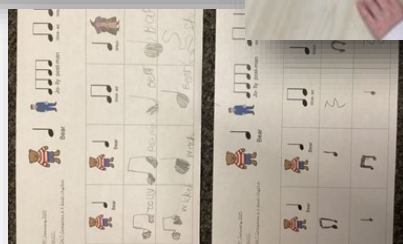


Children used MakeCode to programme a microbit to show their name and an icon.
