6BA, 5HC, 3VW, 3KC 99% they get the chance to have 15 minutes extra choice time next week).

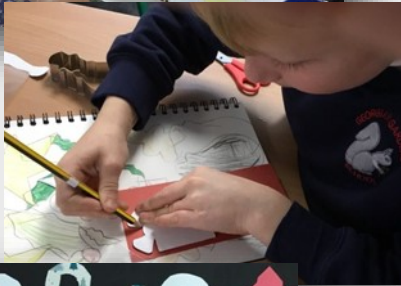

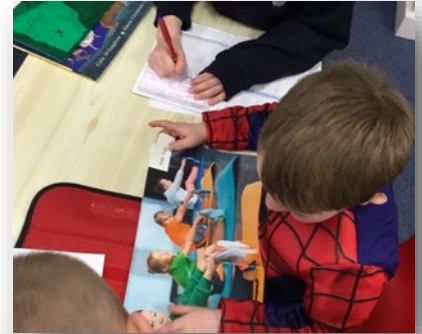

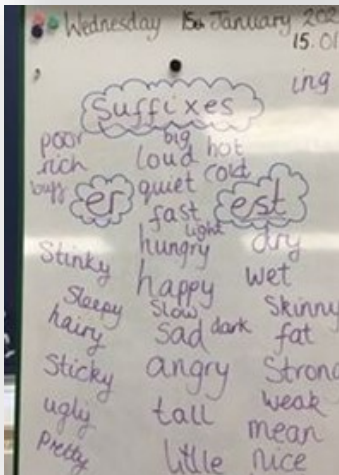

Over three days, we investigated how various liquids impacted on eggshells (representing our teeth). The liquids we used were tea - with and without toothpaste, water, cola and vinegar.

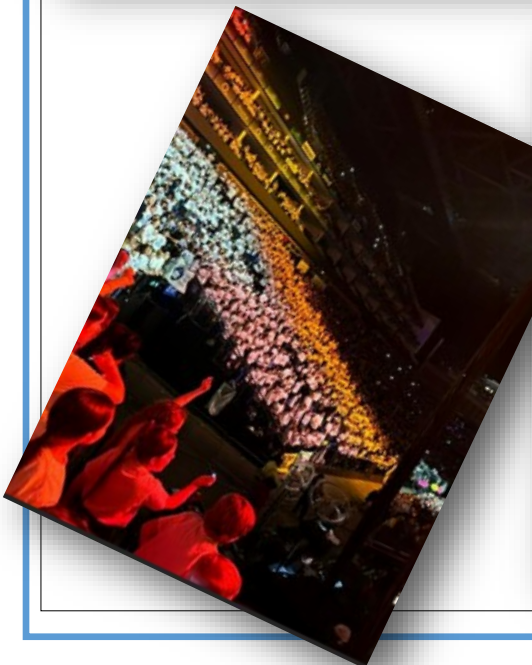
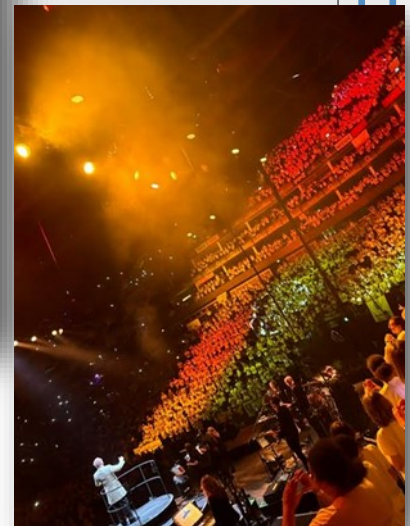
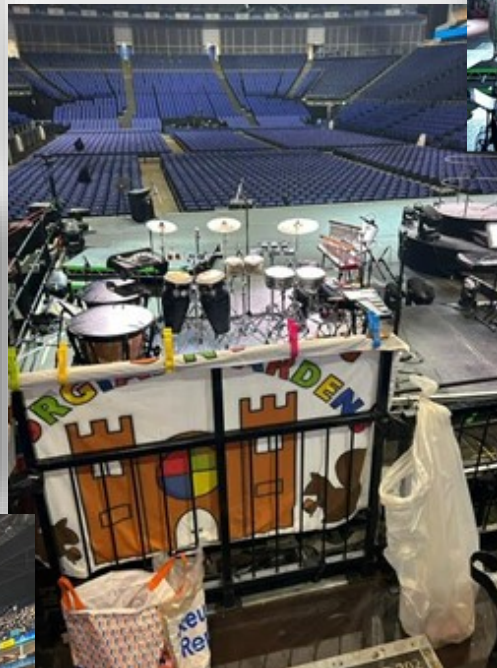
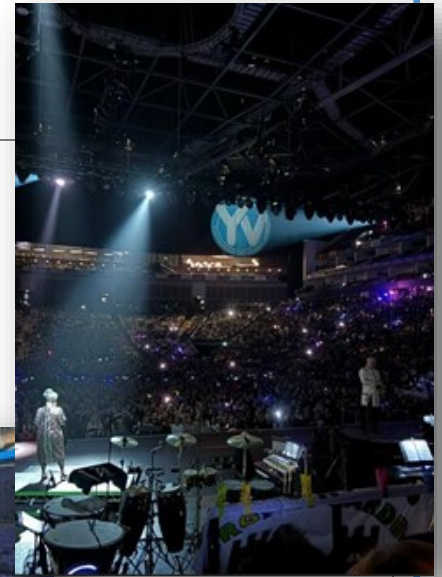


Year 1 learnt about the suffixes er and est. we then tried to think of as many root words to go with them as we could.
