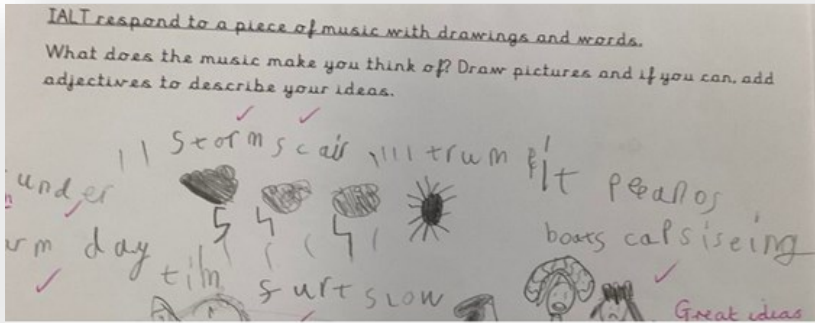

Snapshot of the week:



Year one listened to a piece of mystery music (Storm by Benjamin Britten). They drew pictures of what the music made them think of and added adjectives too. Next lesson they will create their own Storm composition.



Year one created a Storm composition. They used body percussion and sound effects to create the sound of rain, gradually getting louder and stronger. Children had a go at conducting their peers. We added non-pitched percussion instruments to create a class storm. We layered the sounds to change the dynamic, texture and timbre.
