After studying the artist, Rachel Parker, the children created their own repeating patterns which were inspired by everyday items.

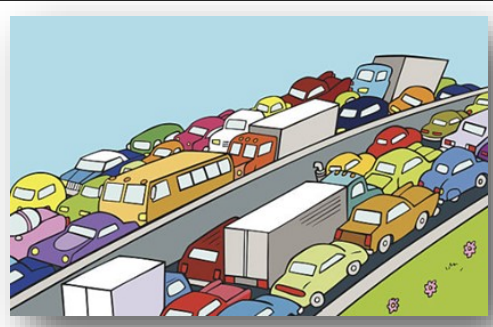


Year 5 science, how are craters formed? Do larger objects make larger craters? We carried out a fair test to assess how craters are made and if the size of the object effects the size of the crater.
