We are a no-nut school. There are children in school with a very serious nut allergy so please avoid sending any food containing nuts (including Nutella). Thank you.

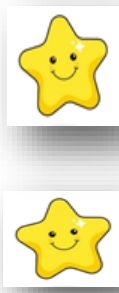

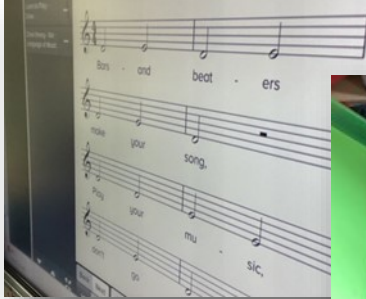
**Attendance:** Whole school: 95% (Sept to now)

**1LG 99%** they get the chance to have 15 minutes extra choice time next week).

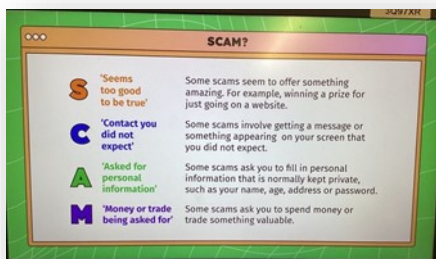
The child with 100% attendance this week: chosen by a random generator:

**Snapshot of the week:** Year 3 learnt how to read a minim and a minim rest. They learnt the notes D and E.

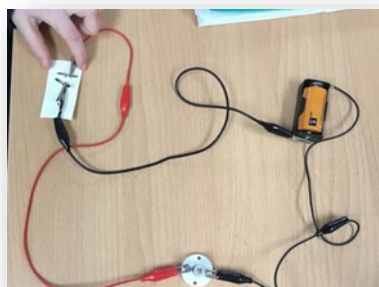

**Why** – to raise awareness of looking after our planet.

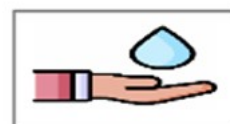
**When/where** – due: Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March and delivered to 4TF (named and class) on this day.
